 - If you have already completed the **NYS** BLS Protocol Update, you do **NOT** need to take this again.

The NYS DOH BEMS will automatically keep records of all participants, but each provider and agency must maintain their own records.

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



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Instructions to locate and access the NYS DOH BLS Adult and Pediatric Protocol Update (NYSDOH only has a BLS version)

<p>1. After you have registered and logged into the EMS Academy site, select Course Catalog.</p>	<p>https://vitalsignsacademy.com/</p> 
<p>2. Find the NYC BLS or ALS Protocol Update, select the version you need and take the course. Once completed, a certificate will be generated. Keep one for your records and give a copy to any agencies you work/volunteer for.</p>	
<p>3. Once you complete the NYC Protocol Update, you must complete the 2019 NYS BLS Adult and Pediatric Protocol Regional Update.</p> <p>If you have already completed the NYS BLS Protocol Update, you do NOT need to take this again</p>	
<p>4. You will see two (2) of these courses posted. One course is long and the other short. Select the 15-minute short course and complete.</p> <p>Once completed, a certificate will be generated. Keep one for your records and give a copy to any agencies you work/volunteer for.</p>
